Thomas Dwyte Evans, age 75, of Winona passed away on October 22, 2019, at St. Dominic's Hospital in Jackson, Mississippi. Mr. Evans, a Jackson native, had been a resident of Winona since 1974.

Dwyte was born on October 1, 1944, to Thomas Jefferson and Carrie Sue Black Evans. He was a wartime baby and was 13 months old when his Daddy saw him for the first time.

Dwyte graduated high school at Provine in Jackson. He attended Meridian Junior College and Mississippi State University before joining the U.S. Air Force, where he spent four years. Dwyte worked in the farming business and cotton ginning, and earned his electrician certification before going to work at Georgia Pacific in Grenada. When GP closed, he retired, then earned his HVAC certification and began to use some of his skills around the community. He sorta became the go-to man with friends and relatives, but he did not paint.

Dwyte married his best friend Sandra, on August 18, 1972, and to their union, they raised two sons and enjoyed all the activities that came with. As of late, they enjoyed some traveling, antiquing, and tailgating at Mississippi State.

Dwyte was predeceased by his parents and one brother, Robert Benton Evans. He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Sandra Land Evans; sons, Thomas J. Evans III, his wife, Rhonda, and Sandy Kenneth Evans, his wife, Rachel; and one brother, W. David Evans, and his wife, Pam. He leaves nieces, nephews, and cousins whom he loved dearly.
