Christmas take-off dates

Defense Force military and civilian personnel and their dependents living off base in a command sponsored status may remove bona fide Christmas gifts received in the mail from persons abroad according to the following rules:

- Personnel must obtain a modified Form 15 from their division officer. The form must be marked "Christmas Presents" and must state the number of parcels that are gifts from abroad to the individual concerned. The form must be signed by the division officer, and the parcels must be presented UNOPENED to Icelandic officials at the Turner Gate. Icelandic officials will open parcels if necessary to verify their contents.
- Christmas gifts in the above

category may be removed between Dec. 2, 1969, and Jan. 10, 1970.

• Removal of the following items under this procedure, is prohibited: electrical appliances, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, perfumes, cameras, silver, and soft drinks.

• Each Defense Force family living off the agreed area may remove one Christmas tree without having it count against the family's weekly take-off. Trees must be
