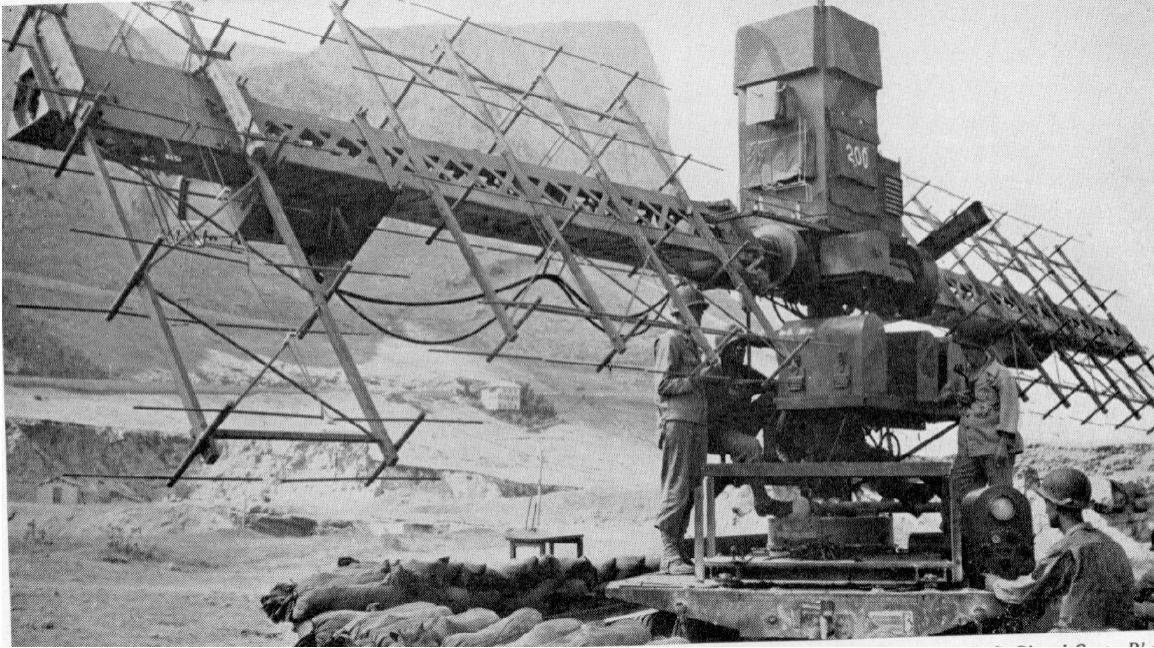


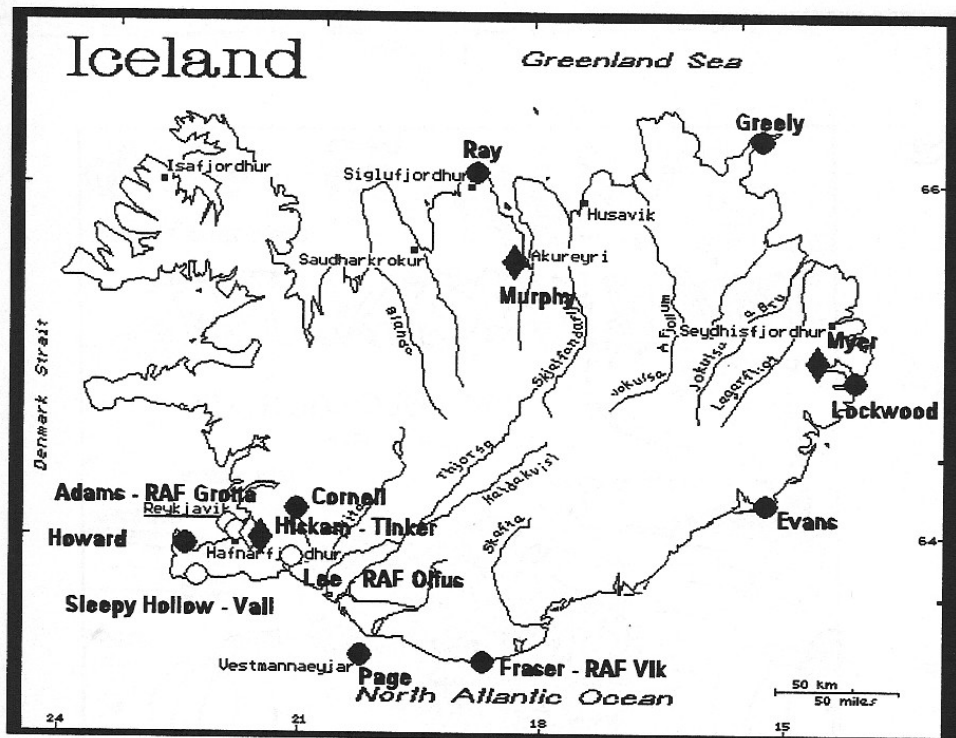

Camp Catherine, the eastern white circle near Reykjavik, is not labeled. The RAF Vik CHL was severely damaged by wind and not operational in Dec 41. It became operational again in 1942. Between Sep 43 and Dec 43, the radars at Ray, Greely, Lockwood, Evans, Page and Cornell and the Information Centers at Murphy and Larkhill were shut down and the camps evacuated.
